

The 2018-19 Miss Ruby's Kids year was an exciting and successful year for our ParentChild+ and Educational Mentoring programs. We served 60 families plus a family care center and recruited additional mentors to help our elementary students. The families attended family sessions in the evenings and participated in Christmas parades and the Mardi Gras celebration. The year culminated with graduation for our second-year families. It was a festive evening with student performances and over 100 people attending the event. Our Coordinators and Early Learning Specialists did a fabulous job with the programs, and we appreciate their dedication. Assessment results showed significant gains in parent/child communication and consistency of interactions. What a great accomplishment!

Throughout our transitions in leadership and staff, Miss Ruby's Kids has developed a strong, highly competent, and successful team to lead the programs into the future. Our Directors, Lisa Haas and Natasha Brockington, are working closely with the Board of MRK to continue the high level of services to our families. 
With a generous donation from the <u>Mustard Seed Charitable</u>




