

Company Overview

Miss Ruby's Kids provides our community with early literacy education and mentoring using evidence-based research, curriculum, and parental coaching to ensure all Miss Ruby's Kids enter school with an equal start. Parents/caregivers will be equipped to confidently engage in their children's education and foster a lifelong love of learning. Our core values represent our shared sense of purpose and are ingrained into the Miss Ruby's Kids culture.

Job Summary

Miss Ruby's Kids is seeking to fill multiple Early Learning Specialists positions for the ParentChild+ program. Both English speaking and Bilingual (English & Spanish) applicants are encouraged to apply. The ParentChild+ program utilizes a national evidence-based school readiness model that preempts the achievement gap by providing young children and their parents with learning tools and skills. Early Learning Specialists visit families twice a week, promoting parent engagement and early literacy skills through reading and play.

Essential Functions

- Complete 16-hours of training delivered by local site Coordinator prior to beginning home visits, and other training mandated by state, locality, or agency, including child abuse and neglect training.
 Conduct twice-weekly visits with program families to demonstrate the use of educational books or toys and to monitor progress.
- Facilitate play and verbal interaction during visits, and show the parent(s) how to engage their child in positive communications, build a strong parent-child relationship, and teach the child the basic concepts s/he will need when it is time to enter kindergarten.
- Demonstrate an adequate level of literacy and observational skills necessary to write anecdotal home session records and to complete child and parent evaluations.
- □ Maintain confidentiality regarding program families and program staff.
- □ Maintain individual records on children including screenings, assessments, referrals, progress reports, documentation of home visitation activities, etc.

Education, Training and Experience

- The minimum education level is a High School Diploma.
- Bilingual applicants must speak and read fluent Spanish and English, act as liaison between bilingual families and MRK, &/or other entities as needed.
